mixed martial arts mma is an emergent sport where competitors in a ring or cage utilize strikes punches kicks elbows and knees as well as submission techniques to defeat opponents this book explores the carnal experience of fighting through a sensory ethnography of mma and how it transgresses the cultural scripts of masculinity in popular culture based on four years of participant observation in a local mma club and in depth interviews with amateur and professional mma fighters spencer documents fighters training regimes and the meanings they attach to participation in the sport drawing from the philosophical phenomenology of martin heidegger maurice merleau ponty and jean luc nancy this book develops bodies centered ontological and epistemological grounding for this study guided by such a position it places bodies at the center of analysis of mma and elucidates the embodied experience of pain and injury and the sense and rhythms of fighting

a veteran hockey writer takes on hockey culture and the nhl addressing the game s most controversial issue whether it s on ice fist fights or head shots into the glass hockey has become a nightly news spectacle with players pummeling and bashing each other across the ice like drunken gladiators and while the nhl may actually condone on ice violence as a ticket draw diehard hockey fan and expert adam proteau argues against hockey s transformation into a thuggish blood sport in fighting the good fight proteau sheds light on

the many perspectives of those in and around the game with interviews of current and former nhl stars coaches general managers and league executives as well as medical experts one of the most well known media figures on the hockey scene today famous for his funny feisty observations as a writer for the toronto star and the hockey news and commentator on cbc radio and tv adam proteau is also one of the few mainstream media voices who is vehemently anti fighting in hockey not only is his book a plea to the game s gatekeepers to finally clamp down on the runaway violence that permeates the sport even at its highest level he offers realistic suggestions on ways to finally clean the game up includes interviews with medical experts on head injuries and concussions as well as with other members of the media the author not only wages an attack on the value of fighting in hockey but also on the establishment hockey culture covering the most polarizing issue in hockey today fighting the good fight gives hockey fans and sports lovers everywhere a reason to stamp their feet and whistle at a rare display of eloquence and common sense

the working class in new york city was remade in the mid nineteenth century in the 1820s a substantial majority of city artisans were native born by the 1850s three quarters of the city s laboring men and women were immigrants how did the influx of this large group of young adults affect the city s working class what determined the texture of working class life during the antebellum period richard stott addresses these questions as he explores the social and economic dimensions of working class culture working class culture stott maintains is grounded in the material environment and when work population consumption and the uses of urban space change as rapidly as they did in the mid nineteenth century culture will be transformed using workers first person accounts letters diaries and reminiscences as evidence and focusing on such diverse topics as neighborhoods diet saloons and dialect he traces the rise of a new youth oriented working class culture by illuminating the everyday experiences of city workers he shows that the culture emerging in the 1850s was a culture clearly different from that of native born artisans of an earlier period and from that of the middle class as well

in this report rand researchers explore the factors contexts and mechanisms that shape a national government s decision to continue or end military and other operations during a conflict i e national will to fight to help u s leaders better understand and influence will to fight the researchers propose an exploratory model of 15 variables that can be tailored and applied to a wide set of conflict scenarios

if as some suggest american literature began with huckleberry finn then the humorists of the old south

surely helped us to shape that literature twain himself learned to write by reading the humorists work and later writers were influenced by it this book marks the first new collection of humor from that region published in fifteen years and the first fresh selection of sketches and tales to appear in over forty years thomas inge and ed piacentino bring their knowledge of and fondness for this genre to a collection that reflects the considerable body of scholarship that has been published on its major figures and the place of the movement in american literary history they breathe new life into the subject gathering a new selection of texts and adding twain the only major american author to contribute to and emerge from the movement as well as several recently identified humorists all of the major writers are represented from augustus baldwin longstreet to thomas bangs thorpe as well as a great many lesser known figures like hamilton c jones joseph m field and john s robb the anthology also includes several writers only recently discovered to be a part of the tradition such as joseph gault christopher mason haile james edward henry and marcus lafayette byrn and features authors previously overlooked such as william gilmore simms ham jones orlando benedict mayer and adam summer selections are timely reflecting recent trends in literary history and criticism sensitive to issues of gender race and ethnicity the editors have also taken pains to seek out first printings to avoid the kinds of textual corruptions that often occur in later versions of these sketches southern frontier humor offers students and general readers alike a broad perspective and new appreciation of this singular form of writing from the old south and provides some chuckles along the way

rose of the winds by k a masterson bred to be a lady but raised to best any man adalyn fairleigh of fairleigh manor is more than meets the eye she is also the pirate queen sailing with her loyal crew and her first love and first mate logan when she captures the attention of lord nathaniel blackstone of montagor he is sorely underprepared for her wit bravery and passion but only one man can ever tame her carefree and wild heart rose of the winds is a wild adventure on the open seas one filled with betrayal swashbuckling and romance

life death and everything in between this is the story of the crossroads of zil a tale about a little girl lost within her own story ends up getting a second chance as she leaves behind the life she once knew and ventures to a place beyond her imagination meeting fantastic characters along the way the girl learns and discovers from each about their own uniqueness and how all of them play a part in the overall design of life and the girl herself you are invited to take an incredible journey as you follow along a little girls travels taking her down the roads of an unforgettable land and finding not only herself but the crossroads of zil

discussions on akrasia lack of control or weakness of will in greek philosophy have been particularly vivid and intense for the past two decades standard stories that presented socrates as the philosopher who simply denied the phenomenon and plato and aristotle as rehabilitating it straightforwardly against socrates have been challenged in many different ways building on those challenges this collective provides new and in some cases opposed ways of reading well known as well as more neglected texts its 13 contributions written by experts in the field cover the whole history of greek ethics from socrates to plotinus through plato aristotle and the stoics cleanthes chrysippus epictetus

drawing on detailed data from their sixteen year study of red winged blackbirds in the marshes of washington s columbia national wildlife refuge beletsky and orians analyze the information redwings use to make breeding season decisions and the consequences these decisions have for lifetime reproductive success because male and female redwings make different and often independent decisions males focus on territory acquisition and maintenance while females must choose when and where to nest and how much energy to invest in reproduction the authors have taken the novel approach of studying the sexes separately using analyses of observational data combined with field experiments and game theoretical models the authors provide new insights into the complex patterns of reproductive decision making and breeding behavior in redwings this book will be of interest to all who study social animals including behavioral ecologists evolutionary biologists and ornithologists

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
