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brian j mcveigh uses a unique anthropological approach to step outside flawed stereotypes of japanese society and really engage in the current debate over the role of bureaucracy in japanese politics to many in the west japan appears as a paradox a rational high tech economic superpower and yet at the same time a deeply ritualistic and ceremonial society this adventurous new study demonstrates how these nominally conflicting impressions of japan can be reconciled and a greater understanding of the state achieved

japan s demographic revival shifts discussions about employing immigration as the best or sole solution to assuaging japan s demographic quagmire to a more systematic approach that identifies structural organizational and cultural impediments that contribute to japan s and other countries declining demographic situations this edited volume also sheds light on the plethora of changes required to produce a demographically sustainable japan part one includes chapters explaining the endogenous ethnocultural and structural obstacles that link ethnocultural understandings of citizenship and nationality part two consists of chapters that provide insight into the societal barriers that exist in japan to address demographic issues part three shifts its focus away from identifying and analyzing the structural organizational and cultural factors towards chapters that are policy oriented linking existing policies as contributing factors behind japan s demographic challenge

this book explores the global history of anti apartheid and international solidarity with southern african freedom struggles from the 1960s it examines the institutions campaigns and ideological frameworks that defined the globalization of anti apartheid the ways in which the concept of

solidarity was mediated by individuals organizations and states and considers the multiplicity of actors and interactions involved in generating and sustaining anti apartheid around the world it includes detailed accounts of key case studies from europe asia and latin america which illustrate the complex relationships between local and global agendas as well as the diverse political cultures embodied in anti apartheid taken together these examples reveal the tensions and synergies transnational webs and local contingencies that helped to create the sense of being global that united worldwide anti apartheid campaigns

examines the rise of post 1970s afro asian cultural production that embodied the aspirations and contradictions entailed in forging black asian identification and solidarity

this is the first book to examine in depth japan s relations with africa japan s dependence on raw materials from south africa made it impossible for tokyo in the 1970s and 1980s to support other african states in their fight against the minority government and its policy of apartheid kwaku ampiah s detailed analysis of japan s political economic and diplomatic relations with sub saharan africa from 1974 to the early 1990s makes it clear that japan was lukewarm in the struggle against apartheid case studies of tanzania and nigeria dissect japan s trade aid and investment policies in sub saharan africa more widely

this book offers the first in depth examination of japanese mongolian relations from the late nineteenth century through to the middle of the twentieth century and in the process repositions mongolia in sino japanese and russo japanese relations beginning in 1873 with the intrepid journey to mongolia by a group of buddhist monks from one of kyoto s largest orders the relationship later included groups and individuals from across japanese society with representatives from the military academia business and the bureaucracy throughout the book the interplay between these various groups is examined in depth arguing that to restrict japan s relationship with mongolia to merely the strategic and as an adjunct to manchuria as has been done in other works neglects important facets of the relationship including the cultural religious and economic it does not however ignore the strategic importance of mongolia to the japanese military the author considers the cultural diplomacy of the zenrin ky kai a japanese quasi governmental humanitarian organization whose activities in inner mongolia in the 1930s and 1940s have been almost completely ignored in earlier studies and whose operations suggest that japanese mongolian relations are quite distinct from other asian peoples accordingly the book makes a major contribution to our understanding of japanese activities in a part of asia that figured prominently in pre war and wartime japanese strategic and cultural thinking

first published in 1986 by the middle of the nineteenth century japan had been a closed country for more than two hundred years then a period of constant communication between japan and the outside world suddenly began the fifteen years war was in effect the intensification of relations between already warring nations during the struggle of 1931 to 1945 japan was engaged in incessant international activity this book is based on lectures given at mcgill university montreal canada from 1979 to 1980

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
