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if the twentieth century was the american century it can be argued that it was more specifically the new york century and greenwich village was the incubator of every important writer artist and political movement of the period from the century s first decade through the era of beatniks and modern art in the 1950s and 60s greenwich village was the destination for rebellious men and women who flocked there from all over the country to fulfill their artistic political and personal dreams it has been called the most significant square mile in american cultural history for it holds the story of the rise and fall of american socialism women s suffrage and the commercialization of the avant garde one villager went so far as to say that everything started in the village except prohibition and in the 1940s the young actress lucille ball said the village is the greatest place in the world what other community could claim a spectrum ranging from henry james to marlon brando from marcel duchamp to bob dylan from gertrude vanderbilt whitney to abbie hoffman the story of the village is in large part the stories old villagers have told new villagers about

former villagers and to tell its story is in large part to tell its legends republic of dreams presents the remarkable outrageous often interrelated biographies of the giants of american journalism poetry drama radical politics and art who flocked to the village for nearly half a century among them eugene o neill whose plays were first produced by the provincetown players on macdougall street for whom edna st vincent millay also wrote jackson pollock who moved to the village from wyoming in 1930 and was soon part of the group of 8th street painters who would revolutionize western painting e e cummings who lived for years on patchin place as did djuna barnes max eastman who edited the groundbreaking literary and political journal the masses which introduced freud to the american public and also published sherwood anderson amy lowell upton sinclair maksim gorky and john reed s reporting on the russian revolution republic of dreams is beautifully researched outspoken wise hip exuberant a monumental definitive history that will endure for decades to come

the united states is known as a country that has been highly antagonistic to socialism of any form socialists in the united states have tended to be political outsiders mounting criticisms of the government without serving in elected office themselves however from around 1900 to 1920 socialist politicians in the united states were prominent and active at the municipal level holding office as government insiders socialist mayors in over two hundred small cities across the united states brought meaningful improvements in the quality of life for people in their communities playing an important role in this period s municipal reform movement despite the limitations of being associated with a minority party particularly a party that divided over whether to pursue elected office in the united states these mayors pushed for reforms challenged the status quo and held their own in demonstrating the ability to govern socialist mayors in the united states is the first comprehensive study of nationwide socialist activity at the municipal level during the progressive era it is a unique study of the socialist mayors in this period their election how they approached their job and what they accomplished berman offers a fresh look at the nature of the socialist party by focusing on its municipal program interaction with non socialist municipal reformers local political operations and the tensions within the party as it delved into political action on this level socialist mayors in the united states is an illumination of seldom explored political and governmental characteristics of medium and small towns often very small towns where socialists enjoyed most of their successes

to many rural iowans the stock market crash on new york s wall street in october 1929 seemed an event far removed from their lives even though the effects of the crash became all too real throughout the state from 1929 to 1933 the enthusiastic faith that most iowans had in iowan president herbert hoover was transformed into bitter disappointment with the federal government as a result iowans directly questioned their leadership at the state county and community levels with a renewed spirit to salvage family farms demonstrating the uniqueness of iowa s rural life beginning with an overview of the state during 1929 lisa l ossian describes iowa s particular rural dilemmas evoking through anecdotes and examples the economic nutritional familial cultural industrial criminal legal and political challenges that engaged the people of the state the following chapters analyze life during the early depression new prescriptions for children s health creative housekeeping to stretch resources the use of farm playlets to communicate new information creatively and memorably the demise of the soft coal mining industry increased violence within the landscape and the movement to end prohibition the challenges faced in the early great depression years between 1929 and 1933 encouraged resourcefulness rather than passivity creativity rather than resignation and community rather than hopelessness of particular interest is the role of women within the rural landscape as much of the increased daily work fell to farm women during this time while the women addressed this work simply as making do ossian shows that their resourcefulness entailed complex planning essential for families emotional and physical health ossian s epilogue takes readers into the iowa of today dominated by industrial agriculture and asks the reader to consider if this model that stemmed from depression era innovation is sustainable her rich rural history not only helps readers understand the particular forces at work that shaped the social and physical landscape of the past but also traces how these landscapes have continued in various forms for almost eighty years into this century

originally published in 1972 a literary history of iowa which features writers published in book form between 1856 and the late 1960s returns to print one of iowa s native sons ellis parker butler once said that in iowa 12 dollars were spent for fertilizer each

time a dollar was spent for literature many readers will be surprised to learn from this book the extent of iowa s distinguished literary past the many prizes and praise received by her authors to those already familiar with iowa s credits a literary history of iowa will be a nostalgic and informative delight during the 1920s and 1930s iowa had good claim to recognition as the literary capital of the country clarence andrews says that as he grew up he knew a host of iowa writers i also knew that iowa was winning a disproportionate share of the pulitzer prizes hamlin garland margaret wilson susan glaspell frank luther mott ding darling clark mollenhoff it was winning its share or more of prizes offered by publishers and its authors books were being selected as book of the month and literary guild books i knew too about carl van vechten as part of that avant garde group of midwest exiles including fitzgerald anderson and hemingway a literary history of iowa looks at iowans who knew and cared for the state people who wrote poetry plays musical plays novels and short stories about iowa subjects iowa ideas iowa people these writers often have dealt with such themes as the state s history the rise of technology and its impact on the community provincialism and exploitation the problems of personal adjustment and the family and the community john t frederick whose own books are paramount in iowa s literary history has pointed to iowa s special contributions to the literature of rural life in saying that no other state can show its portrayal in fiction so rich so varied and so generally sound as can iowa

in the early twentieth century an exuberant band of gifted men and women moved to new york city not to get rich but to participate in a cultural revolution for them the city s immigrant neighborhoods home to art poetry cafes and cabarets in the european tradition provided a place where the fancies and forms of a new america could be tested some called themselves bohemians some members of the avant garde but all took pleasure in the exotic new and forbidden in american moderns christine stansell tells the story of the most famous of these neighborhoods greenwich village which thanks to cultural icons such as eugene o neill isadora duncan and emma goldman became a symbol of social and intellectual freedom stansell eloquently explains how the mixing of old and new worlds politics and art and radicalism and commerce so characteristic of new york shaped the modern american urban scene american moderns is both an examination and a celebration of a way of life that s been nearly forgotten

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
