no religious text has influenced the world more than has the new testament s sermon on the mount and yet this crucial text still begs to be more clearly understood why was it written what unifying theme or purpose holds it all together should it be called a sermon or is it some other kind of composition how would its earliest listeners have heard its encoded allusions and systematic program this book offers new insights into the sermon on the mount by seeing it in the shadow of the all pervasive temple in jerusalem which dominated the religious landscape of the world of jesus and his earliest disciples analyzing matthew 5 7 in light of biblical and jewish backgrounds ritual studies and oral performances in early christian worship this reading coherently integrates every line in the sermon it positions the sermon as the premier christian mystery

introduces mishnah the oral law of judaism received by mores from god at mount sinai

in hispanojewish archaeology alexander bar magen numhauser provides the first book length archaeological exploration of the jewish presence in late antique and early medieval hispania using epigraphic numismatic architectural and other archaeological remains this volume describes the multiple cultural expressions of a vibrant jewish community that emerged as part of the mediterranean diaspora becoming part of the wider hispanian society part of this review includes a detailed examination of the ilici elche spain basilical building interpreted by previous scholars as both a church and a synagogue using published and hitherto unpublished material of its decades long excavation from the archaeological remains of this hispanojewish presence a new picture emerges challenging the traditional premises of the archaeological research on the late antique western mediterranean

the world's three great monotheistic religions have spent most of their historical careers in conflict or competition with each other and yet in fact they sprung from the same spiritual roots and have been nurtured in the same historical soil this book an extraordinarily comprehensive and approachable comparative introduction to these religions seeks not so much to demonstrate the truth of this thesis as to illustrate it frank peters one of the world's foremost experts on the monotheistic faiths takes judaism christianity and islam and after briefly tracing the roots of each places them side by side to show both their similarities and their differences volume i the peoples of god tells the story of the foundation and formation of the three monotheistic communities of their visible historical presence volume ii the words and will of god is devoted to their inner life the spirit that animates and regulates them peters takes us to where these religions live their scriptures laws institutions and intentions how each seeks to worship god and achieve salvation and how they deal with their own orthodox and heterodox and with others the goyim the pagans the infidels throughout he measures but never judges one religion against the other the prose is supple the method rigorous this is a remarkably cohesive informative and accessible narrative reflecting a lifetime of study by a single recognized authority in all three fields the monotheists is a magisterial comparison for students and general readers as well as scholars of the parties to one of the most troubling issues of today the fierce sometimes productive and often destructive competition among the world's monotheists the siblings called jews christians and muslims

the term niddah means separation during her menstrual flow and for several days thereafter a jewish woman is considered niddah separate from her husband and unable to practice the sacred rituals of judaism purification in a miqveh a ritual bath following her period restores full status as a wife and member of the jewish community in the contemporary world debates about niddah focus less on the literal exclusion of menstruating women from the synagogue instead emphasizing relations between husband and wife and the general role of jewish women in judaism although this has been the law since ancient times the meaning and practice of niddah has been widely contested women and water explores how these purity rituals have affected jewish women across time and place and shows how their own interpretation of niddah often conflicted with rabbinic views these essays also speak to contemporary feminist issues such as shaping women's identity power relations between women and men and the role of women in the sacred

stuart miller examines the hermeneutical challenges posed by the material and literary evidence pertaining to ritual purity practices in graeco roman palestine and especially the galilee he contends that stepped pools which we now know were in use well beyond the destruction of the temple and as indicated by the large collection on the western acropolis of sepphoris and elsewhere into the middle and late roman byzantine eras must be understood in light of biblical and

popular perspectives on ritual purity the interpretation of the finds is too frequently forced to conform to rabbinic prescriptions which oftentimes were the result of the sages unique and creative nominalist approach to ritual purity special attention is given to the role ritual purity continued to play in the lives of ordinary jews despite or because of the loss of the temple miller argues against the prevailing tendency to type material finds and jewish society according to known groups pre 70 c e pharisaic sadducaic essenic post 70 c e rabbinic priestly etc he further counters the perception that ritual purity practices were largely the interest of priests and argues against the recent suggestion that the kohanim resurfaced as an influential group in late antiquity building upon his earlier work on sages and commoners miller claims that the rabbis emerged out of a context in which a biblically derived complex common judaism thrived stepped pools stone vessels and other material finds are realia belonging to this complex common judaism a careful reading of the rabbis indicates that they were acutely aware of the extent to which ritual purity rites pertaining to home and family life had spread which undoubtedly contributed to their intense interest in regulating them
